Mobile data collection for employees on the go

UKG offers a mobile app well suited for districts with dispersed or mobile employees, such as homebound teachers, maintenance workers, or IT staff, who are constantly on the move across locations. Instead of filling out lengthy timesheets at the end of a shift, employees can punch in and out on their Apple, Android, or Windows mobile device in real time. The app leverages the GPS capability on the smartphone or tablet to track the location of the punch for better communication and reduced time theft.

Your bus drivers, for example, can leverage the mobile app to record normal shifts worked as well as extra duty time for field trips, athletic events, and more. Their time worked can be captured in real-time or offline mode depending on the mobile device options available within your district. The mobile app's advanced functionality extends beyond data collection, giving employees immediate access to schedule and labor data. Employees can submit timesheets; transfer between jobs, cost centers, and labor levels; and view their schedules, time-off and leave-of-absence calendars, and accrual balances — all from their mobile phone or tablet. Managers can use the app to approve timesheets, view reports, respond to employee time-off or leave-of-absence requests, and resolve exceptions as they happen. These capabilities improve communication between employees and managers and enable everyday workforce management tasks to be completed quickly and efficiently.
